Good Morning,

FACULTY and PARENTS please make note of the following IMPORTANT dates below:

**Monday and Tuesday, April 10th and 11th:** Grade 9 FSA Reading (5 school days away - Graduation Requirement Exam)

**Wednesday and Thursday, April 12th and 13th:** Grade 10 FSA Reading (7 school days away - Graduation Requirement Exam)

- Each Grade 9 and 10 student will test on 2 days for the FSA Reading. (1 session per day.)
- If your child is absent on their test day, make-up exams are offered.
- 
- **ALL students should be using the KHAN ACADEMY** free online program on weekly basis to prepare for BOTH the FSA and the SAT.
- Algebra 2 EOC exams begin the week of April 17th
- Geometry and Algebra 1 EOC exams begin the week of April 24

A HUGE "shout-out" to Mr. Shane and our West Boca Band Students... as it was a very busy last couple of days for the program!

On Friday, the West Boca Jazz Band performed at the FBA State Jazz Band Assessment held at Pompano Beach HS. The jazz band received a "Straight Superior" rating, which is the highest possible score. We were one of only 4 schools in Palm Beach County to receive top marks at State!

Also on Saturday, our Percussion ensemble traveled up to Daytona to finish their winter season at the FFCC Championships at the Ocean Center. West Boca took the Silver Medal in the Scholastic Concert Open Class, scoring 2<sup>nd</sup> in the State and was the highest scoring group from South Florida in our class!

**Parents, as we enter the testing season these are some things to keep in mind:**

-- During PSAT, FSA, EOC, and Midterm/Final Exams students are not permitted to leave campus while the test is in progress. Once the testing period has begun students must stay in their class until the end of the period. Please plan appointments accordingly. Thank you for your cooperation.

-- Students may not have cell phones, smart watches or any other electronic devices near them during testing. These items will be collected and kept in a safe place until testing is complete.

-- All students need to have a photo ID with them at all times so the Testing Administrators can verify their identity. (Student IDs can be purchased in the media center. They are \$5 for the first ID, which is good all four years you are at West Boca, and \$2.50 for replacements. Any new or

returning students that need IDs can stop by at any time.)

- Please bring headphones/earbuds for testing.
- Please make sure students are well fed and rested on testing days.
- State of the art software programs examine all testing results and can statistically pinpoint students who may have shared answers. If this occurs, student tests may be invalidated.
- Encourage your child to relax, do his or her best, and rely on the testing tips and preparation which has been ongoing within our classrooms.

### FSA (Florida State Assessment) Practice Tests

Content-specific practice tests are available for students at <http://fsassessments.org/students-and-families/practice-tests/>. These Practice Tests are intended to familiarize students with the types of items that will make up the tests and with the tools that will be available to them.

### PERT Test Announcement:

If you currently need your Algebra 1 graduation requirement. Besides passing the Algebra 1 EOC, you can earn the credit by taking the PERT math test. I will be administering the PERT test and I have scheduled you to attend. The testing schedule is listed below. On the back, you will find your student ID number and the period you will report to testing on the days listed below. The tests consists of 30 questions and you do not need to bring any materials.
